Vineyards:

Sunset – Quincy basin sediments deposited by the great Missoula flood, silty clay soils at elevation of 1,300 ft

Weyns – Frenchman Hills growing area, ancient wind blown, silty loam soil above the flood plain at 1,375 ft

Talcott – Wahluke Slope vineyard composed of deep coarse sand over deposited river rock.
